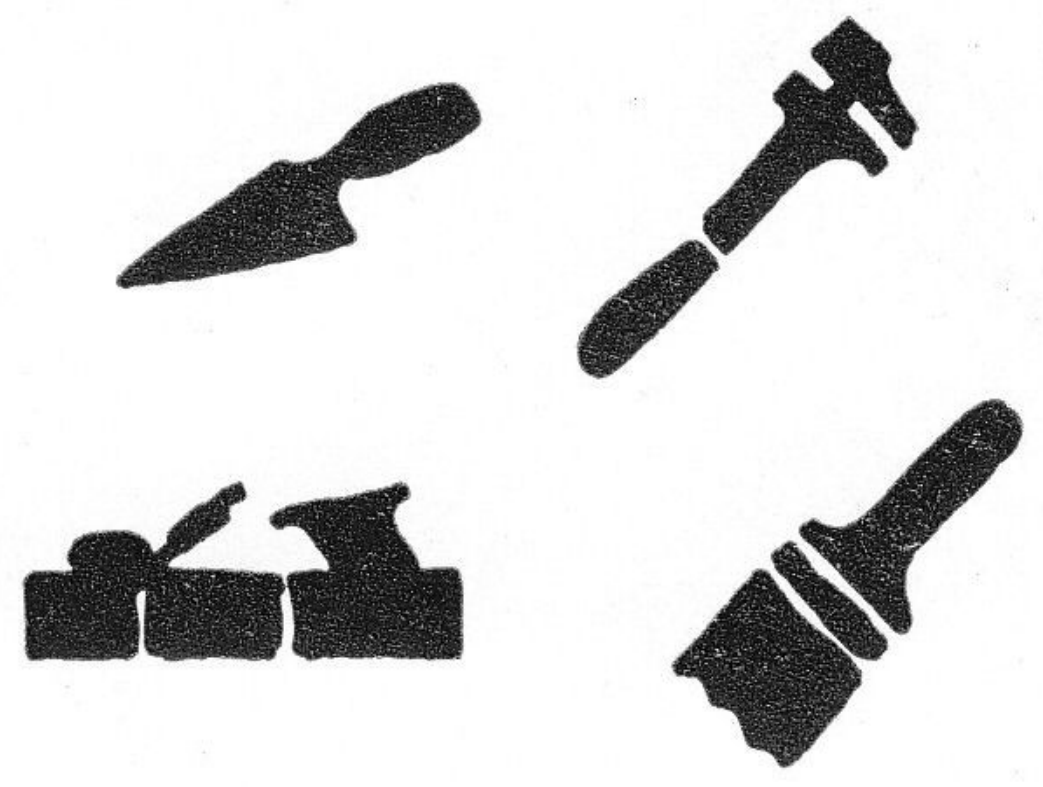
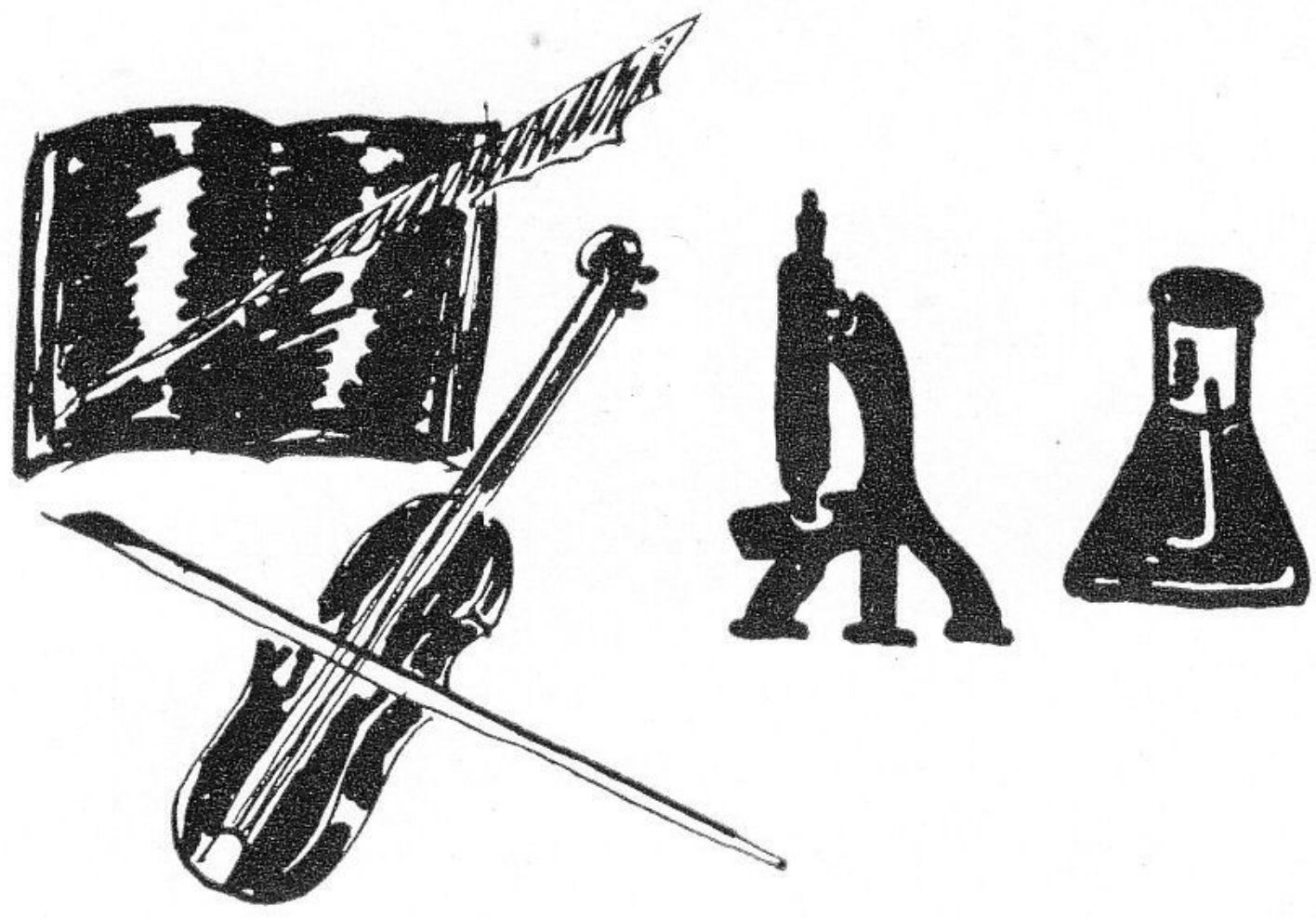
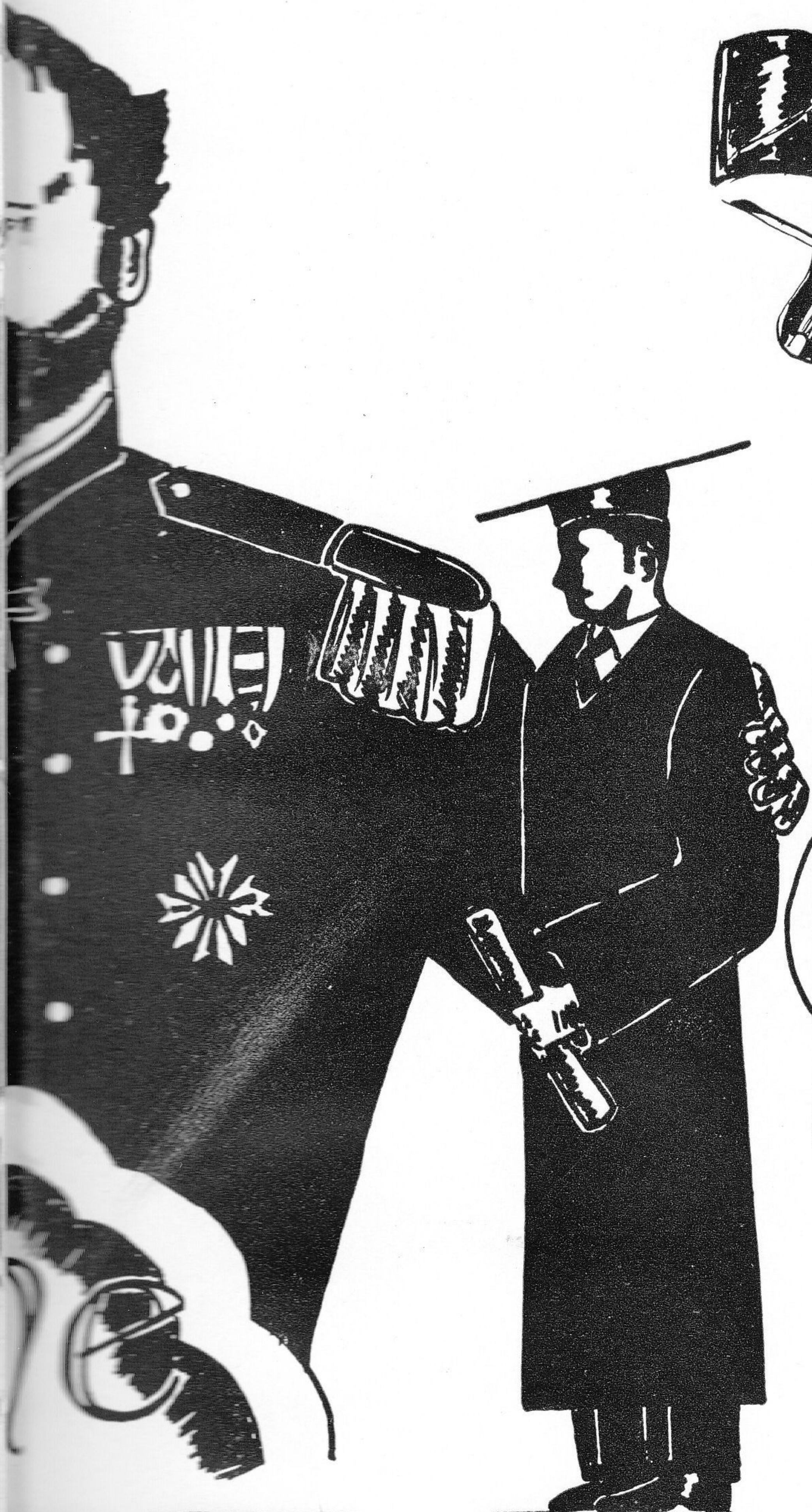
# Foreword . . .

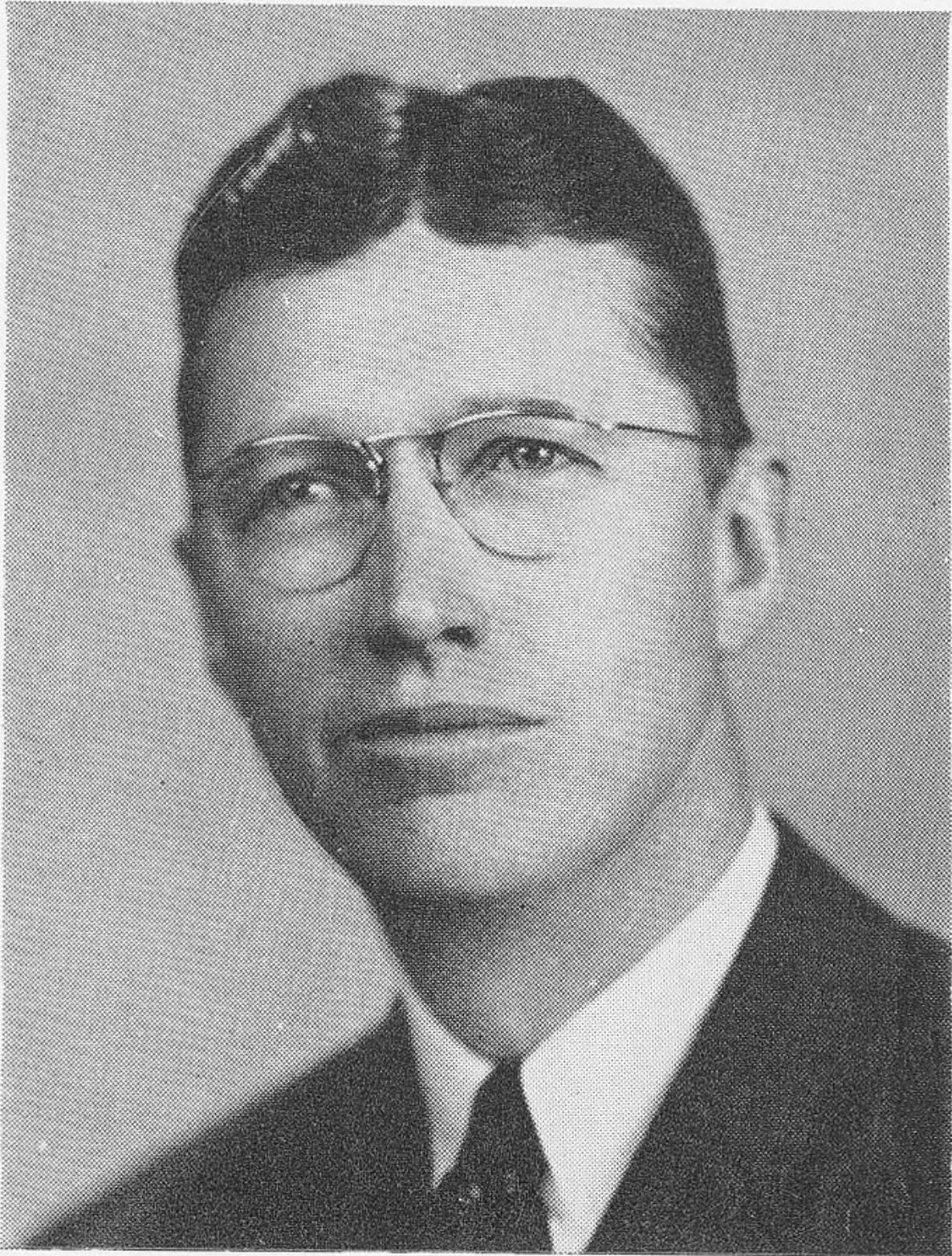
We raise our voices now to greet thee,

Our unconquered Cradock High.

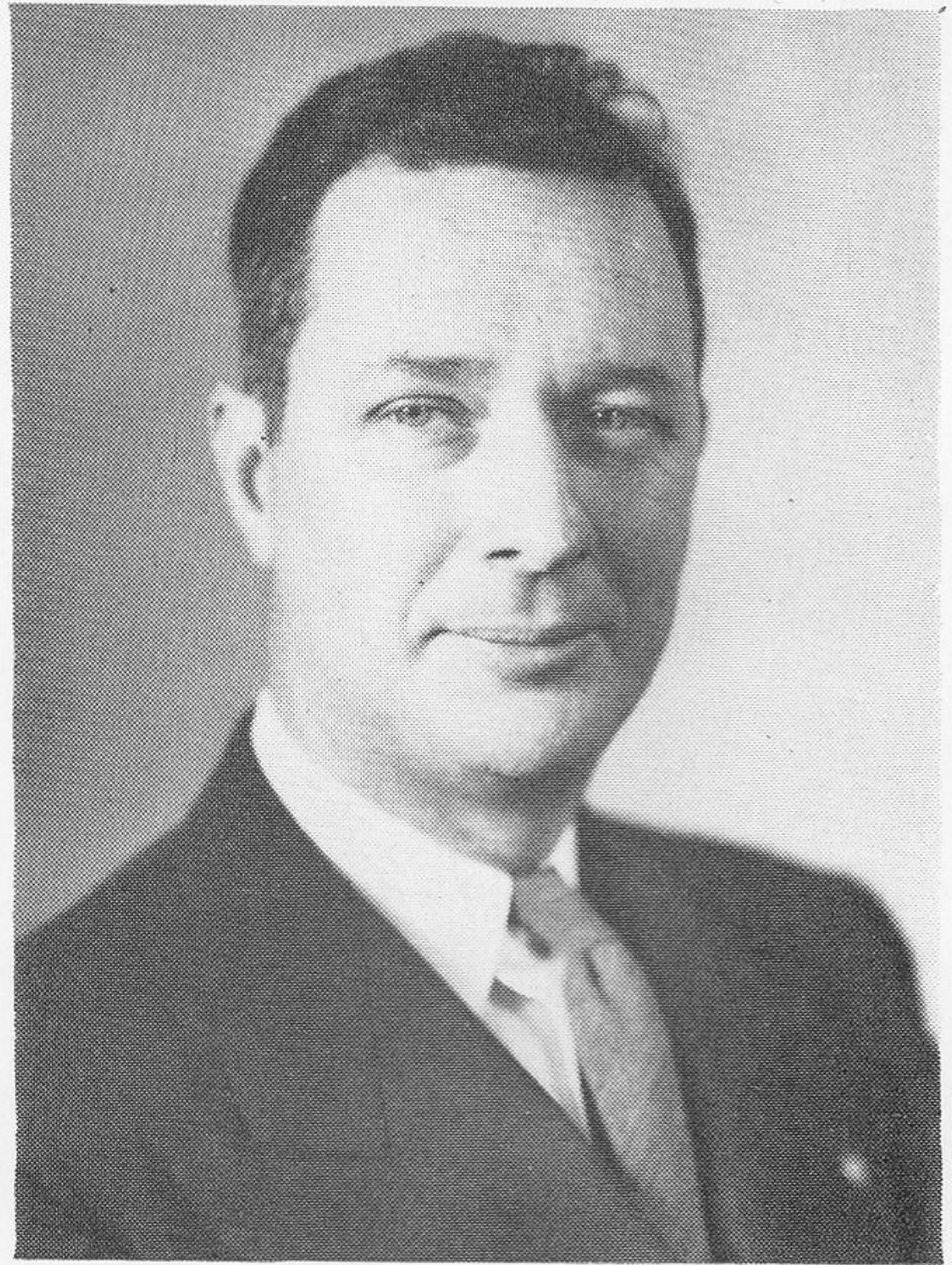
