Steve finally catches on as Mr. Wulzer explains a problem.

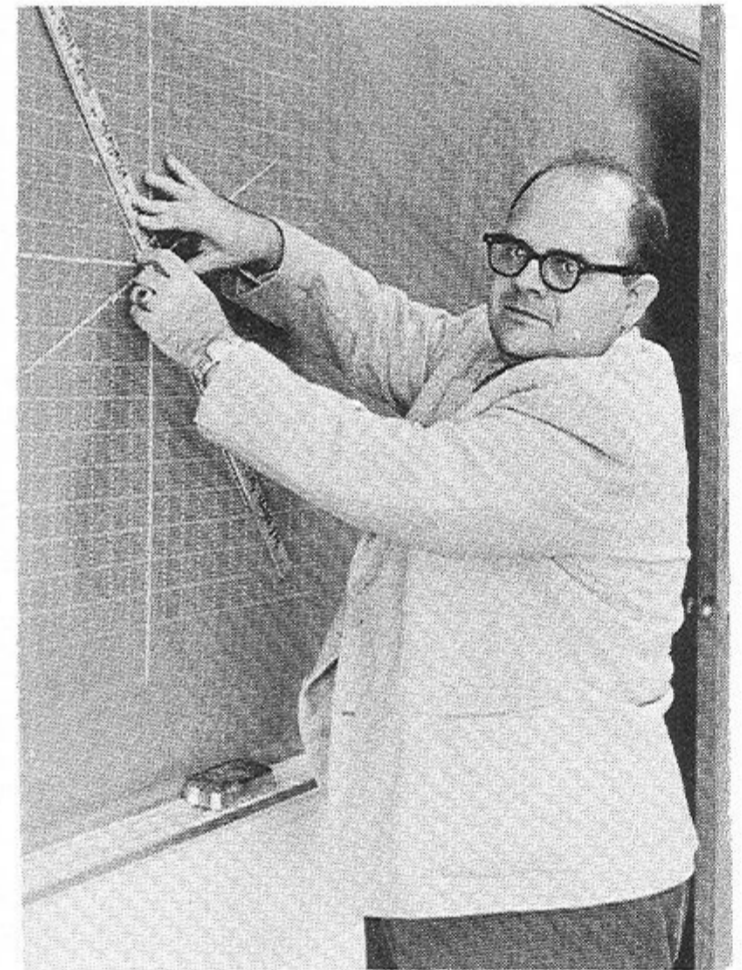

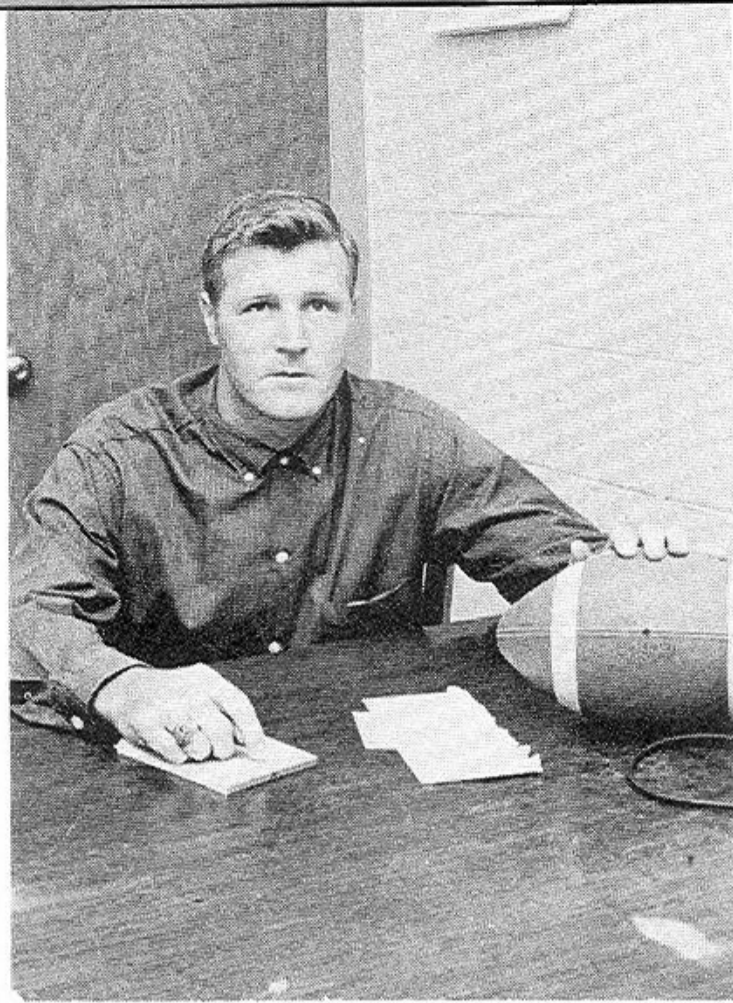
